- ▶ 1. ____ Recipients have the right to know if program has a policy for discharging clients who fail to comply with program rules which could lead to program discharge
- ▶ 2. ____ Recipient may participate in the development of their own treatment plan
- ▶ 3. ____ Recipient may present grievances or suggest changes in program policies and services to program staff, to governmental officials, or to another person within or outside the program. In this process, the program shall not in any way restrain the recipient.
- ▶ 4. ____ Recipient is prohibited from doing any work which the program would otherwise employ someone else to do, even if the work and the rationale for its therapeutic benefit are included in program policy or in client treatment plan
- ▶ 5. ____ An initial complaint of a recipient rights violation shall be investigated by the regional rights advisor.
- ▶ 6. ____ An appeal received by the coordinating agency shall be reviewed by the coordinating agency rights consultant within 15 working days of receipt, unless the time limitation is waived in writing by the complainant.
